Dear Public Service Director.

In a survey conducted in April of this year, one in nine adults with children in the U.S. reported that their children were not getting enough to eat. Several times higher than it was before the COVID-19 pandemic, this figure reveals an intolerable increase in the number of hungry and food-insecure children nationally. Although recent government interventions like the American Rescue Act have been meaningful in their support for the most vulnerable families, this summer will be a critical time for many of them as they confront new challenges in trying to recover economically from more than a year of hardship.

Feed the Children, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, has pursued its vision of a world without childhood hunger since 1979. We are dedicated to helping families and communities achieve stable lives and to reducing the need for help tomorrow while providing food and assistance to help them today. To do this, we distribute product donations of food and other resources from corporate donors through our network of local community partners across the United States. We also manage child-focused community development programs in nine countries around the world.

If current encouraging trends continue, in this country we may well put the worst of this health crisis behind us soon. As life begins to return to normal, however, it would be unconscionable to allow our "new normal" to include widespread childhood hunger.

Please help inform your audience about how they can help hungry children and struggling families this summer by airing the new PSAs "Hunger Shouldn't Be Normal| Feed the Children | Donate At" (:30) and "Hunger Shouldn't Be Normal | Feed the Children | Learn How You Can Help" (:30). These PSAs draw an important contrast between the relief we feel as we look forward to a possible end to the health crisis and the fact that many people are still suffering. While they are extremely timely now, we would like to set a specific end date of August 31, 2021 for using these PSAs. However, for airing beyond this date, we have also included evergreen PSAs in both 30-second and 60-second formats. Regardless of how many of our PSAs you choose to broadcast, we hope that you will support both our summer campaign and our general mission by airing them as soon and as often as possible.


