Chloe holds the stocking and looks at the military shrine on the fireplace mantel. Chloe looks up at her mom who smiles and nods in approval. Chloe hangs her dad's stocking. As she pulls away, her bracelet catches, and the thread unravels the D in Dad. Lucy gallops out of the room. Lucy returns and presents Chloe's mom with a small sewing kit. She stitches the stocking as Lucy and Chloe watch in anticipation. Chloe hangs the repaired stocking on the fireplace. Magically, stitched angel wings and a halo appear around the name, "Dad." As she pulls away, her bracelet catches and the thread unravels the D in Dad. Lucy gallops out of the room and returns with a small sewing kit. Dear Taxpayer:

We're responding to your request dated July 27, 2022, about your tax-exempt status.

We issued you a determination letter in June 1985, recognizing you as tax-exempt under Internal Revenue Code (IRC) Section 501(c) (3).

- Form 990-PF, Return of Private Foundation or Section 4947(a)(1)
 Trust Treated as Private Foundation

According to IRC Section 6033(j), if you don't file a required annual information return or notice for 3 consecutive years, we'll revoke your tax-exempt status on the due date of the 3rd required return or notice.
