

Dear Public Service Director,

Children are placed in foster care after enduring abuse, neglect, parental drug use or other issues, and many have experienced countless layers of trauma, grief and loss in their lives. The priority of the foster care system is to keep families together. But when a judge has ruled that it is unsafe for a child to return to their family of origin, they need someone to step forward to adopt them. In the United States, more than 350,000 children are in foster care, more than 100,000 of whom are available for adoption.

But every day, more than 50 youth age out of the system without a permanent family, leaving them at a higher risk of experiencing homelessness, unemployment and other negative outcomes.

Created in 1992 by Wendy's[®] founder Dave Thomas who was adopted, the Dave Thomas Foundation for Adoption is a national, nonprofit public charity dedicated to dramatically increasing the number of adoptions of children waiting in North America's foster care systems.

Through our <u>Wendy's Wonderful Kids[®] program</u>, the Foundation supports the hiring of adoption recruiters who serve children and youth most at risk of aging out of care without a family. We also work to remove barriers for families pursuing adoption by advocating for adoption and foster care benefits in the workplace, by supporting innovative grant-making and by promoting free educational resources.

We are committed to elevating the national conversation about the urgent need for foster care adoption and dispelling the myths and misperceptions that surround the children in care. And we diligently advocate for policies and practices that improve the systems with which children and families are involved.



Dear Applicant:

This modifies our letter of the above date in which we stated that you would be treated as an organization that is not a private foundation until the expiration of your advance ruling period.

Your exempt status under section SO1(a) of the Internal Revenue Code as an organization described in section SO1(c)(3) is still in effect. Based on the information you submitted, we have determined that you are not a private foundation within the meaning of section SO3(a) of the Code because you are an organization of the type described in section SO3(a)(2).

Grantors and contributors may rely on this determination unless the Internal Revenue Service publishes notice to the contrary. However, if you lose your section 509(a)(2) status, a grantor or contributor may not rely on this determination if he or she was in part responsible for, or was aware of, the act or failure to act, or the substantial or material change on the part of the organization that resulted in your loss of such status, or if he or she acquired knowledge that the Internal Revenue Service had given notice that you would no longer be classified as a section 509(a)(2) organization.

If we have indicated in the heading of this letter that an addendum applies, the addendum enclosed is an integral part of this letter.

Because this letter could help resolve any questions about your private foundation status, please keep it in your permanent records.
